Application documents required are as follows:

1. A copy of the National Identity Card (ID)
2. A copy of the appointment letter
3. A notified copy of the Diploma
4. Notified copies of Academic Transcripts
5. A recommendation of good conduct issued by the school Head teacher and approved by the Sector Executive Secretary
6. A current in-service testimonial issued by the school Head teacher indicating the teaching experience in TVET of the applicant.
7. A proof of scores from the assessments of performance contracts issued by the Head teacher corresponding with the years of teaching in TVET.

To meet the deadline set by RTB, all application documents should be submitted to the District Central Secretariat not later than Tuesday, 23/01/2024, at 05:00 PM. We encourage eligible candidates to take advantage of this opportunity and submit their applications promptly.

RE: Request for the nomination of TVET teachers eligible for enrollment in the Bachelor of Technology programs for the academic year 2024

Reference is made to the Presidential Order No 123/01 of 15/10/2020 establishing the Rwanda TVET Board (RTB) with the responsibility to coordinate programs and activities to ensure trainers' development, build their capacities, and monitor their management;

As part of our ongoing efforts to enhance the qualifications and expertise of TVET teachers, the Rwanda TVET Board is in the process of compiling a list of eligible teachers to pursue their further studies at Rwanda Polytechnic (RP) during the academic year 2024. This initiative is aligned with our commitment to fostering excellence in technical and vocational education, as outlined in the aforementioned presidential order.

Therefore, Rwanda TVET Board requests you to send a list of five qualified TVET teachers from the schools in your respective Districts who are willing to pursue a Bachelor of Technology at Rwanda Polytechnic **for the upcoming intake**. The inclusion of eligible teachers in this list is crucial for the successful implementation of our programs and the continued improvement of the technical and vocational education sub-sector.

Interested teachers must meet the following requirements:

1. Being a Rwandan by nationality
2. Being a teacher in Public or Government Aided schools
3. Having at least 2 years of teaching experience in a Public/Government Aided Technical Secondary School or Vocational Training Center
4. Being under 35 years of age
5. Have an advanced diploma/diploma with at least Second-Class/Upper Division or a qualification deemed equivalent
6. He has not been sentenced by the courts of law to a prison sentence equal to or more than 6 months
7. He has not been suspended from work for 3 months



8. In the assessments made by the employer, the teacher has never received a score below 70%
9. Having completed at least a TVET advanced diploma in:
 - i. Agricultural Mechanization technology
 - ii. Air Conditioning and Refrigeration Technology
 - iii. Animal Health
 - iv. Crop Production
 - v. Applied Forestry
 - vi. Electronics and Telecommunication
 - vii. Water and Sanitation
 - viii. Highway Engineering
 - ix. Geomatics Engineering
 - x. Tourism Management
 - xi. Mining Technology
 - xii. Irrigation and Drainage Technology
 - xiii. Mechatronics Technology
 - xiv. Quantity Surveying
 - xv. Renewable Energy
 - xvi. Wildlife and Landscape management


We kindly request that the list of all nominated teachers for the intake of March 2024 be submitted no later than 26th January 2024 via email at info@rtb.gov.rw. Additionally, for your convenience, the required format for submission is enclosed in the annex to this letter.

Note: We also remind you that the teachers who will go to study in the academic year 2024/2025 are on the waiting list approved by RP this year 2023/2024 and sent to your respective districts. Therefore, they are not eligible for this coming enrolment phase.
